DECISION

Dispute Codes OPM, MND, MNSD, FF

Introduction

This hearing was scheduled to deal with the landlord's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* ("Act") for:

- an Order of Possession enforcing a mutual agreement to end tenancy pursuant to section 55;
- a monetary order for unpaid rent and damage pursuant to section 67;
- authorization to keep all or a portion of the security deposit pursuant to section 38; and
- authorization to recover the filing fee for this application from the tenant pursuant to section 72.

The tenant did not attend this hearing. The landlord attended the hearing and was given a full opportunity to be heard, to present affirmed testimony, to make submissions and to call witnesses.

At the outset the landlord testified that this matter had settled and they withdrew their application.

Conclusion

The landlord's entire application is withdrawn and dismissed without leave to reapply.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
