<u>Introduction</u>

This matter was set for hearing by telephone conference call at 9:00 a.m., in response to a Tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution (the "Application") to cancel a notice to end tenancy for cause. The telephone line remained open while the phone system was monitored for ten minutes and no participant called into the hearing during this time.

Analysis & Conclusion

Rule 7.3 of the Residential Tenancy Branch Rules of Procedure states if a party or their agent fails to attend the hearing, the Arbitrator may conduct the dispute resolution hearing in the absence of that party, or dismiss the Application, with or without leave to re-apply.

As neither party called into the conference call by 9:10 a.m., I hereby dismiss the Tenant's Application with leave to re-apply. I have made no findings of fact or law or extended any deadlines with respect to the merits of this Application. This Decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
