A matter regarding VANCOUVER WEST PROPERTY MANAGEMENT INC. and [tenant name suppressed to protect privacy] <u>DECISION</u>

Dispute Codes MNSD, MND, MNDC, FF

Introduction

This hearing dealt with the landlord's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* ("*Act*") for:

- a monetary order for unpaid rent and for money owed or compensation for damage or loss under the *Act*, *Residential Tenancy Regulation* ("*Regulation*") or tenancy agreement, pursuant to section 67;
- authorization to retain the tenant's security deposit in partial satisfaction of the monetary order requested, pursuant to section 38; and
- authorization to recover the filing fee for its application from the tenant, pursuant to section 72.

The tenants did not attend this hearing. The landlord attended the hearing and was given a full opportunity to be heard, to present affirmed testimony, to make submissions and to call witnesses.

At the outset of this hearing, the landlord confirmed that he wished to withdraw his application as the parties have settled the matter. Accordingly, the landlord's entire application is withdrawn.

Conclusion

The landlord's entire application is withdrawn.
