## DECISION

Dispute Codes MT, CNR, OLC

### Introduction

This hearing dealt with the tenant's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "Act") for:

- more time to make an application to cancel the landlord's 10 Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent (the "10 Day Notice") pursuant to section 66;
- cancellation of the landlord's 10 Day pursuant to section 46; and
- an order requiring the landlord to comply with the *Act*, *Residential Tenancy Regulation* ("Regulation") or tenancy agreement pursuant to section 62.

The landlord did not participate in the conference call hearing, which lasted approximately 10 minutes. The tenant's agent attended the hearing and confirmed she was an agent of the tenant named in this application, and had authority to speak on her behalf.

### Preliminary Issue - Withdrawal

At the outset of the hearing the tenant's agent indicated that the tenant had vacated the rental unit and seeks to withdraw her entire application as she no longer seeks to cancel the 10 Day Notice.

### Conclusion

As the claim has been withdrawn, no further action is required and the file is closed accordingly.
