DECISION AND RECORD OF SETTLEMENT

<u>Dispute Codes</u> CNL, DRI, ERP, MNDC, MNSD, OLC, RP, RR, FF

Section 63 of the *Act* provides that if the parties settle their dispute during a hearing the Director may record the settlement in the form of a decision or an order. Pursuant to the above provision, discussion between the parties during the hearing led to a settlement / resolution. Specifically, the parties agreed and confirmed as follows;

- 1. the tenant and landlord agree to set aside the 2 Month Notice;
- 2. the tenant and landlord agree that this tenancy will continue until it is ended in accordance with the *Act*;
- 3. the tenant and landlord agree that no later than May 30, 2017, the landlord will repair the following;
 - three electrical outlets in the living room
 - two electrical outlets in the kitchen
 - three elements on the stove
 - the stove oven
 - back door
 - rat infestation and rat holes
 - bathroom shower leak
 - dryer vent
- 4. the tenant and landlord agree that May 2017 rent is waived and therefore the tenant is not responsible for May 2017 rent;
- 5. the tenant and landlord agree that the tenant will deduct \$100.00 from June 2017 rent as compensation for the paid filing fee.

The above particulars comprise **full and final settlement** of all aspects of the dispute arising from this application. The parties confirmed at the end of the hearing that this agreement was made on a voluntary basis and that the parties understood the nature of this full and final settlement of this matter.

This Decision and Settlement Agreement are final and binding on both parties.

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Conclusion

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
