A matter regarding ASSOCIA BRITISH COLUMBIA INC. and [tenant name suppressed to protect privacy]

DECISION

<u>Dispute Codes</u> MNDC, MNSD, FF

<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was scheduled to deal with the tenant's application pursuant to the Residential Tenancy Act ("Act") for:

- a monetary order for compensation for loss under the *Act*, regulation or tenancy agreement pursuant to section 67;
- authorization to obtain a return of all or a portion of her security deposit and pet damage deposit pursuant to section 38; and
- authorization to recover the filing fee for this application from the landlord pursuant to section 72.

Both parties attended the hearing and were given a full opportunity to be heard, to present affirmed testimony, to make submissions and to call witnesses. The corporate landlord was represented by its two agents.

During the hearing, after the parties presented some of their respective evidence, and the landlord outlined their position, the tenant testified that she did not wish to pursue this matter and withdrew their application.

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Conclusion

The tenant's entire application is withdrawn and dismissed without leave to reapply.
