## **DECISION**

### Introduction

This hearing convened as a result of a Tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution filed March 22, 2017 wherein the Tenant sought "other" relief. On the Application, the Applicant recorded their name as Tenant and Landlord; the Applicant failed to submit any evidence which may clarify this information.

This matter was set for hearing by telephone conference call at 9:00 a.m. on this date. The line remained open while the phone system was monitored for ten minutes and no participant called into the hearing during this time.

### Analysis and Conclusion

As the Applicant did not call into the hearing by 9:10, I dismiss the claim with leave to reapply. I note this does not extend any applicable time limits under the Act.

This decision is final and binding on the parties, except as otherwise provided under the Act, and is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
