Introduction and Analysis

This telephone conference call hearing was convened as the result of the landlord's application for dispute resolution under the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "Act") filed June 21, 2017. The landlord applied to end the tenancy early on the basis that the tenant is an immediate threat to life or property.

The hearing began promptly at 11:00 a.m. Pacific Time on Monday, July 24, 2017, as scheduled and the telephone system remained open and was monitored for 11 minutes. During this time, neither the applicant landlord nor the respondent tenant dialed into the telephone conference call hearing.

Conclusion

In the absence of both parties, I dismiss the landlord's application, with leave to reapply.

This decision is final and binding on the parties, unless otherwise provided under the Act, and is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under s. 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
