Introduction

This hearing dealt with the tenant's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the *Act*) for:

- an application to cancel a notice to end tenancy pursuant to section 49;
- an application for a monetary order pursuant to section 67; and
- other unspecified relief.

Both the landlord and the attended the hearing. Both parties were given a full opportunity to be heard, to present their sworn testimony and to make submissions. Following introductory remarks the tenant stated that she wished to withdraw this entire application.

I explained to the tenant that withdrawing this application would conclude the hearing and this matter would be dismissed without leave to re-apply. The tenant stated she understood this and wished to proceed with the withdrawal of the application.

Conclusion

The tenant's application to cancel a Notice to End Tenancy, for a Monetary Order, and for other unspecified relief was withdrawn by the tenant and is therefore dismissed without leave to reapply.
