## **DECISION**

## Introduction

This hearing dealt with the tenant's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the *Act*) for:

• an Order directing the landlord to comply with section 62 of the Act.

The landlord, the tenant and a witness attended the hearing. All parties were given a full opportunity to be heard, to present their sworn testimony and to make submissions.

Following introductory remarks the tenant stated that he wished to have arbitrator with the *Residential Tenancy Branch* order that the landlord serve a tenant in the building with a Notice to End Tenancy. I explained to the tenant that I did not have the authority to do this under section 62 of the *Act*. The tenant accordingly, withdrew his application.

I explained to the tenant that withdrawing this application would conclude the hearing and this matter would be dismissed without leave to re-apply. The tenant stated he understood this and wished to proceed with the withdrawal of the application.

The tenant's application named the respondent as S Property Manager. Pursuant to section 64(3)(c), I have amended the tenant's application to reflect the proper name of the landlord with whom he wished to serve the action.

## Conclusion

The tenant's application for an Order directing the landlord to comply with the *Act* is dismissed.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
