This hearing dealt with the Tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution, received at the Residential Tenancy Branch on July 20, 2017. The Tenant applied to dispute a Notice of Rent Increase, dated June 15, 2017, pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act*.

This matter was set for hearing by telephone conference call at 9:00 A.M. (Pacific Time) on October 3, 2017. The line remained open while the phone system was monitored for ten minutes and no participant called into the hearing during this time. Therefore, as the Applicant did not attend the hearing by 9:10 A.M., I dismiss the claim with leave to reapply. This is not an extension of any statutory deadline.
