<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing convened as a result of the Tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution wherein the Tenant requested an Order cancelling a Notice to End Tenancy for Cause issued on July 21, 2017 (the "Notice").

Both parties appeared at the hearing. The hearing process was explained and the participants were asked if they had any questions. Both parties were provided the opportunity to present their evidence orally and in written and documentary form, and make submissions to me.

Settlement and Conclusion

At the outset of the hearing the Landlord advised that the parties had resolved matters by mutual agreement. The terms of their agreement is recorded in this my Decision pursuant to section 63 of the *Residential Tenancy Act* and Rule 8.4 of the *Residential Tenancy Branch Rules of Procedure*. As the parties resolved matters by agreement I make no findings of fact or law with respect to their relative claims.

Settlement and Conclusion

The parties confirmed at the end of the hearing that this agreement was made on a voluntary basis and that the parties understood the nature of this full and final settlement of this matter.

The terms of their settlement follow.

1. The Notice shall be withdrawn.

- 2. The tenancy shall continue until ended in accordance with the Act.
- 3. The Tenant shall not access the roof of the rental building, and shall not feed birds and other wildlife on the rental property.
