Introduction

On May 29, 2017, the Tenant submitted an Application for Dispute Resolution seeking the return of a security deposit or pet damage deposit.

This matter was set for hearing by telephone conference call at 1:30 PM on this date. Therefore, as the Applicant did not attend the hearing by 1:40 pm, I dismiss the claim with leave to reapply. This is not an extension of any statutory deadline.
