A matter regarding CAPREIT and [tenant name suppressed to protect privacy] **DECISION**

<u>Dispute Codes</u> MT CNC

<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was convened as a result of the Tenants' Application for Dispute Resolution. A hearing by telephone conference was held on November 10, 2017. The Tenants applied for the following relief, pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the *Act*):

- more time to make an application to cancel the landlord's 1 Month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause (the 1 Month Notice) pursuant to section 66; and,
- cancellation of the landlord's 1 Month Notice pursuant to section 47.

This matter was set for hearing by telephone conference call at 9:30 A.M. (Pacific Time) on November 10, 2017. The line remained open while the phone system was monitored for ten minutes and no participant called into the hearing during this time. Therefore, as the Applicants did not attend the hearing by 9:40 A.M., I dismiss the claim with leave to reapply. This is not an extension of any statutory deadline.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
