Introduction

This hearing was convened as a result of the Tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution. The participatory hearing was held, via teleconference, on November 1, 2017. The Tenant applied for the following relief, pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "*Act*"):

Cancel the Landlord's Notice to End Tenancy for Landlord's Use of Property

The Landlord and the Tenant both attended the hearing and provided affirmed testimony. Both parties were provided the opportunity to present evidence orally and in written and documentary form, and to make submissions to me.

At the start of the hearing, the Tenant requested to withdraw her application and stated that she and the Landlord have already resolved their issues. Given that the Tenant withdrew her application in full, I make no findings on the merits of the matter.

Conclusion

The Tenant's application has been withdrawn in full.
