RECORD OF SETTLEMENT

<u>Dispute Codes</u> MNSD, MND, MNDC, OPL, FFT, FF

Section 63 of the *Residential Tenancy Act* provides that the parties may attempt to settle their dispute during a hearing. Pursuant to this provision, discussion between the parties during the hearing led to a resolution. Specifically, it was agreed as follows;

- 1. Both parties agree that the landlord can retain the security and pet deposit.
- 2. Both parties agree that neither party will pursue any further monetary claims in relation to this tenancy through the Branch and that this matter is resolved and closed.

The parties confirmed at the end of the hearing that this agreement was made on a voluntary basis and that the parties understood the nature of this full and final settlement of this matter.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
