DECISION

<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was convened in response to the Landlord's Application for Dispute Resolution, in which the Landlord applied for an Order of Possession, a monetary Order for unpaid rent, and to recover the fee for filing this Application for Dispute Resolution.

Issue(s) to be Decided

Is the Landlord entitled to an Order of Possession and to a monetary Order for unpaid rent?

Background and Evidence

The hearing was scheduled for 9:00 a.m. on November 21, 2017. By the time the teleconference was terminated the Tenant had appeared but the Landlord had not appeared.

<u>Analysis</u>

I find that the Landlord failed to diligently pursue the application and I therefore dismiss the application without leave to reapply.

Conclusion

The Landlord's Application for Dispute Resolution is dismissed.
