<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was convened as a result of the Landlord's Application for Dispute Resolution. The Landlord applied for multiple remedies, pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "*Act*").

This matter was initially set to be heard on January 2, 2018, but was adjourned because of a technical issue with respect to the transmission and service of evidence. No issues were heard on January 2, 2018, and the whole application was adjourned to January 25, 2018, at 11:00 am (Pacific Time). This time was clearly listed on the Notice of Adjourned hearing provided. The line remained open while the phone system was monitored for ten minutes and no participant called into the hearing during this time. Therefore, as the Applicants did not attend the hearing by 11:10 A.M., I dismiss the claim with leave to reapply. This is not an extension of any statutory deadline.
