Introduction

This hearing dealt with an application by the tenant pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* to cancel a notice to end tenancy for cause. The landlord did not attend the hearing. The tenant's advocate attended the hearing and was given full opportunity to present evidence and make submissions.

At the start of the hearing, the tenant's advocate (SM) informed me that the parties had had a meeting and had resolved all issues with regard to this dispute. SM stated that during that meeting the landlord cancelled the notice to end tenancy and agreed to allow the tenancy to continue. SM agreed that all aspects of the dispute were resolved.

Conclusion

At the tenant's request this application is dismissed.
