## **DECISION**

## <u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution by the tenant to cancel a One Month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause, issued on December 18, 2018.

Both parties appeared. During the hearing the parties agreed to settle these matters, on the following conditions:

- 1) The landlord agreed to extend the effective date in the notice to end the tenancy, which was January 31, 2018 to May 31, 2018;
- 2) The parties agreed that the tenancy will end on May 31, 2018;
- 3) The parties agreed that should the tenant be violent or harass any other occupants or the landlord between now and the ending of the tenancy that the landlord is at liberty to apply for an earlier end to tenancy.

This settlement agreement was reached in accordance with section 63 of the Residential Tenancy Act.

## Conclusion

As a result of the above settlement, landlord is granted an order of possession.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
