<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with an application by the tenant pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* to cancel a notice to end tenancy for non-payment of rent, dated December 02, 2017.

The tenant served the landlord with the notice of hearing on December 05, 2017 by registered mail and provided a tracking number. Despite having been served, the landlord did not attend the hearing. The tenant attended the hearing and was given full opportunity to present evidence and make submissions.

At the outset of the hearing, the tenant informed me that she had moved out on December 31, 2017. Since the tenant has applied to cancel the notice to end tenancy but has already moved out, her application is most and accordingly dismissed.

Conclusion

The tenant's application is dismissed.
