Introduction

This hearing was scheduled to address the tenant's application pursuant to the Residential Tenancy Act ("the Act") for cancellation of the landlord's 2 Month Notice to End Tenancy for Landlord's Use pursuant to section 49 and authorization to recover the filing fee for this application from the landlord pursuant to section 72.

Both parties attended this hearing (tenant representative and landlord). The tenant's representative requested to withdraw the tenant's application, indicating that this matter had been resolved. With consent confirmed by the landlord, the application is therefore withdrawn.

Conclusion

The tenant's application is withdrawn.
