DECISION

This hearing was convened as a result of the Tenants' Application for Dispute Resolution, made on October 5, 2017. The Tenants applied for an order granting return of all or part of the security deposit or pet damage deposit, pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act*.

This matter was set for hearing by telephone conference call at 1:30 P.M. on March 20, 2018. The line remained open while the phone system was monitored for ten minutes and no participant called into the hearing during this time. Therefore, as the Applicants did not attend the hearing by 1:40 P.M., I dismiss the claim with leave to reapply. This is not an extension of any statutory deadline.
