Introduction

This hearing dealt with the landlord's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (*"Act*") for:

• an Order of Possession for cause, pursuant to section 55.

The two tenants did not attend this hearing, which lasted approximately 6 minutes. The landlord's agent ("landlord") attended the hearing and was given a full opportunity to be heard, to present affirmed testimony, to make submissions and to call witnesses.

At the outset of the hearing, the landlord testified that the tenants had vacated the rental unit, she took back possession of the unit and she did not require an order of possession. I notified her that I would be dismissing her application without leave to reapply and she confirmed her agreement and understanding of same.

Conclusion

The landlord's application is dismissed without leave to reapply.
