Introduction

This hearing dealt with the tenant's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the *Act*) for:

- an order requiring the landlord to comply with the *Act*, regulation or tenancy agreement pursuant to section 62;
- an order to allow access to or from the rental unit or site for the tenants or the tenants' guests pursuant to section 70; and
- an Order of Possession of the rental unit pursuant to section 54.

Both parties attended the hearing and were given a full opportunity to be heard, to present their sworn testimony, to call witnesses, and to make submissions.

At the beginning of the hearing the tenants indicated that they had moved out. As this tenancy has now come to an end, the tenants indicated that they are withdrawing their entire Application. Accordingly, the tenants' entire Application is cancelled.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
