## **DECISION**

### Introduction

On February 9, 2018, the Tenants made an Application for Dispute Resolution seeking an Order for the Landlord to comply with the Act, Regulation, or tenancy agreement.

Neither party attended at the appointed time set for the hearing, although I waited 15 minutes to enable them to participate in this hearing scheduled for 9:30 AM on April 16, 2018. I confirmed that the correct call-in numbers and participant codes had been provided in the Notice of Hearing. I also confirmed from the teleconference system that I was the only person who had called into this teleconference. Therefore, as the Applicants did not attend the hearing by 9:45 AM, I dismiss this claim with leave to reapply. This does not extend any applicable time limits under the Act.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
