DECISION

<u>Dispute Codes</u> FF CNL DRI

<u>Analysis</u>

This hearing dealt with the tenants' application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the *Act*) for:

- A cancellation of the landlords' 2 Month Notice to End Tenancy for Landlords Use of Property ("2 Month Notice") pursuant to section 49 of the Act;
- Dispute of an additional rent increase pursuant to section 43 of the Act; and
- A return of the filing fee pursuant to section 72 of the Act.

Both named landlords and tenant C.H. attended the hearing. Following opening remarks, the tenant, C.H. said that he would like to withdraw his application because the tenants and the landlords had reached a mutual agreement to end tenancy. The landlords confirmed that the parties had reached a mutual agreement.

Accordingly, the tenants' application is withdrawn.
