Introduction

This hearing dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution by the tenant effectively to cancel a Notice to End for unpaid rent.

The applicant tenant was provided with a copy of the Notice of a Dispute Resolution Hearing after filing their application dated February 26, 2018. The tenant, however, did not attend the hearing set for today at 9:30 a.m. The phone line remained open for no less than ten minutes and the teleconference system was monitored throughout this time. The only party to call into the hearing was the respondent landlord, whom informed the hearing the tenant vacated February 28, 2018.

Analysis and Conclusion

Following the ten minute waiting period, the application of the tenant was **dismissed**, without leave to reapply.
