Introduction

This hearing dealt with the tenant's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "Act") for:

- an order to the landlord to provide services or facilities required by law pursuant to section 65;
- authorization to change the locks and/or to suspend or set conditions on the landlord's right to enter the rental unit pursuant to section 70;
- an order requiring the landlord to comply with the Act, regulation or tenancy agreement pursuant to section 62;

While the respondents attended the hearing by way of conference call, the applicant did not, although I waited until 10:45 a.m. in order to enable the applicant to connect with this teleconference hearing scheduled for 10:30 a.m.

Accordingly, in the absence of the applicant's participation in this hearing, I order the application dismissed without leave to reapply.

The respondent P.P. who is the owner of the rental property is not named correctly in the application. I have used the correct name as provided by the respondent in this decision.

Conclusion

The application is dismissed without leave to reapply.
