DECISION

Introduction and Analysis

This hearing dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution (“application”) by the tenant under the *Residential Tenancy Act* (“Act”) to cancel a 10 Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent or Utilities, for more time to make an application to cancel a notice to end tenancy, for an order to suspend or set limits on the landlord’s right to enter the rental unit, site or property, and to recover the cost of the filing fee.

The hearing began promptly at 9:30 a.m. Pacific Time on Friday, August 31, 2018, and the telephone line was monitored for a total of 10 minutes. During this time, neither the applicant tenant nor the respondent landlord called into the hearing. I have confirmed that the conference codes were correct and that I was the only person on the teleconference line for the entire 10 minutes.

Following the ten minute waiting period, the application of the tenant was **dismissed with leave to reapply**.

Conclusion

The tenant’s application is dismissed with leave to reapply.

Given the above, I have not considered the merits of the tenant’s application.

I note this decision does not extend any applicable time limits under the Act.

This decision is final and binding on the parties, except as otherwise provided under the Act, and is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
