Introduction

This hearing was convened as a result of the Tenants' Application for Dispute Resolution. The participatory hearing was held, by teleconference, on September 7, 2018. The Tenants applied for to cancel a 1-Month Notice to End Tenancy, pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "*Act*").

The Respondent/Landlord attended the hearing. The hearing was by telephone conference and began promptly, as scheduled, at 9:30 am. Pacific Time on September 7, 2018, as per the Notice of a Dispute Resolution Hearing provided to the Tenants. The line remained open while the phone system was monitored for 10 minutes and the only participant who called into the hearing during this time was the Respondent/Landlord who was ready to proceed. The Landlord testified that the Tenants are moving out of the rental unit and they do not need an order of possession.

After the ten minute waiting period, the Tenants' application was **dismissed**, **in full**, **without leave to reapply**. Further, given that the Tenants are moving out, the Landlord no longer needs an order of possession, pursuant to section 55 of the Act.

Conclusion

The Tenants' application is dismissed, in full, without leave to reapply.
