<u>Introduction</u>

This is an application by the tenants under the *Residential Tenancy Act (Act)* for an order that the landlord comply with the *Act*, regulation, and/or the tenancy agreement, pursuant to section 62.

This matter was set for hearing by telephone conference. The tenants appeared and were given a full opportunity to provide affirmed testimony and to submit evidence. The landlord did not attend although I left the teleconference hearing connection open for an additional twenty minutes to enable them to call. I confirmed that the correct call-in numbers and participant codes had been provided in the Notice of Hearing. I also confirmed from the teleconference system that I was the only one who had called into this teleconference.

At the outset of the hearing, the tenants withdrew their application.

Conclusion

In the absence of any evidence or submissions, I order this application dismissed with leave to reapply.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the Residential Tenancy Act.
