DECISION AND RECORD OF SETTLEMENT

<u>Dispute Codes</u> CNR

The tenant sought to cancel the 10 Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent ("10 Day Notice"). Section 63 of the *Act* provides that if the parties settle their dispute during a hearing the Director may record the settlement in the form of a decision or an order. Pursuant to the above provision, discussion between the parties during the hearing led to a settlement / resolution. Specifically, the parties agreed and confirmed as follows;

- 1. the tenant and landlord agree to set aside the 10 Day Notice;
- 2. the tenant and landlord agree that this tenancy will continue until it is ended in accordance with the *Act*.

The above particulars comprise **full and final settlement** of all aspects of the dispute arising from this application.

This Decision and Settlement Agreement are final and binding on both parties.
