Introduction

This hearing dealt with an application from the tenant pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the *Act*) for:

• an order directing the landlord to comply with the Act.

Both the landlord's agent, R.M. and the tenant attended the hearing. Following introductory remarks the tenant said the landlord had offered to move him to a new suite, away from the person causing disturbances to his unit. The tenant confirmed he had accepted the offer of a new suite and confirmed there were no other issues presently before me for consideration.

I explained to the tenant that withdrawing the notice would end the proceedings and this tenancy would continue until it was ended at a future date in accordance with the *Act*. The tenant explained he understood this and wish to proceed with the withdrawal.

Conclusion

The tenant's application directing the landlord to comply with the Act is withdrawn.
