<u>Introduction</u>

This matter dealt with an application by the Tenant for the return of the security deposit and for compensation for loss or damage under the Act, regulations and tenancy agreement.

This matter was set for hearing at 1:30 p.m. on this date. The applicant failed to attend the hearing by 1:40 p.m.

Residential Tenancy Branch Rules of Procedure, section 10.1, provides:

10.1 Commencement of the dispute resolution proceeding

The dispute resolution proceeding must commence at the scheduled time unless otherwise decided by the arbitrator. The arbitrator may conduct the dispute resolution proceeding in the absence of a party and may make a decision or dismiss the application, with or without leave to re-apply.

In the absence of an appearance by the applicant by 1:40 p.m., this application is abandoned and dismissed with out leave to reapply.
