DECISION

Introduction

This hearing dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution by the tenants to cancel a One Month Notice to End Tenancy, to be allowed to assign or sublet, to suspend, or set conditions on the landlord's right to enter the rental unit, and to recover the filing fee from the landlord.

Both parties appeared. During the hearing the parties agreed to settle these matters, on the following conditions:

- 1) The parties agreed that the tenancy is legally ending on January 15, 2018 (today); and
- 2) The landlord is entitled to an order of possession.

This settlement agreement was reached in accordance with section 63 of the *Residential Tenancy Act.*

As a result of the above settlement, the landlord is granted an order of possession should the tenants fail to comply with the settlement agreement.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
