DECISION

This hearing dealt with the landlord's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the Act) for:

an order of possession for cause pursuant to section 55.

The landlord's agent (the landlord) attended the hearing via conference call and provided undisputed affirmed testimony. The tenant did not attend or submit any documentary evidence.

At the outset, the landlord stated that the tenant has vacated the rental unit and as such, no longer require an order of possession and wished to cancel the application for dispute. As such, no further action is required.
