Introduction:
This hearing was convened in response to an Application for Dispute Resolution filed by

the Tenant in which the Tenant applied for the return of the security deposit.

Issue(s) to be Decided:

Is the Tenant entitled to the return of security deposit?

Background and Evidence:

The teleconference hearing was scheduled to begin at 1:30 p.m. today. I joined the teleconference at 1:31 p.m. The Agent for the Landlord joined the teleconference prior to 1:3 1 p.m. By the time the teleconference was terminated at 1:42 p.m. the Tenant had not attended.

I confirmed that the correct call-in numbers and participant codes had been provided in the Notice of Hearing. I also confirmed from the teleconference system that the Agent for the Landlord and I were the only ones who had called into this teleconference.

Analysis:

I find that the Tenant failed to diligently pursue the Application and I therefore dismiss the Application without leave to reapply.

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Conclusion:

The Application is dismissed without leave to reapply.
