<u>Introduction</u>

This matter was convened in response to an application by the tenant to control the landlord's right to enter the rental unit and they further sought for the landlord to be ordered to comply with the Act.

Both parties attended the hearing. At the outset of the hearing the applicant advised they had vacated the rental unit and that the tenancy effectively has ended. Having advised the parties that the tenant's application was no longer relevant, both were offered opportunity to mutually resolve other outstanding matters of the tenancy, to no avail. The landlord provided having a pending application with a hearing scheduled for June 2019.

Analysis and Conclusion

As the tenant's matter before this hearing is no longer relevant, therefore without remedy under the Act, it is dismissed without leave to reapply.

This Decision is final and binding.
