DECISION

Dispute Codes: CNC, MT, LRE, MNDCT, OLC, FFT

Introduction:

The Application for Dispute Resolution filed by the Tenants seek the following:

- a. An order to cancel the one month Notice to End Tenancy dated January 18, 2019 and setting the end of tenancy for February 28, 2019.
- b. An order for more time to make this application
- c. An order restricting or suspending the landlord's right to enter the rental unit.
- d. An order for a monetary order in the sum of \$1746.51
- e. An order that the landlord comply with the Act, Regulations and/or tenancy agreement.
- f. An order to recover the cost of the filing fee.

One of the Applicants appeared for the hearing. The Respondents failed to attend the hearing. I waited 10 minutes to enable them to call in and participate in this hearing. I checked that the hearing was scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on April 2, 2019. I confirmed that the correct call-in numbers and participant codes had been provided in the Notice of Hearing.

The Applicant stated that they had reached a settlement with the landlords and that she wished to withdraw the Application. As a result of the settlement I ordered that the application dismissed without liberty to reapply.

This decision is final and binding on the parties.
