Introduction

This hearing dealt with the landlord's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the *Act*) for:

- an Order of Possession for unpaid rent pursuant to section 55 of the Act, and
- recovery of the filing fee from the tenant pursuant to section 72 of the Act.

The tenant did not attend this hearing, although I left the teleconference hearing connection open until 9:45 a.m. in order to enable the tenant to call into this teleconference hearing scheduled for 9:00 a.m. The landlord's son R.L. attended with the landlord to assist her, and they are herein referred to as "the landlord". I confirmed that the correct call-in numbers and participant codes were provided in the Notice of Dispute Resolution Proceeding. I also confirmed from the teleconference system that the landlord and I were the only ones who had called into this teleconference.

The landlord confirmed that the 10 Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent dated January 28, 2019 was missing the effective vacancy date. As such, the landlord withdrew the Application. I accept the landlord's request to withdraw this Application. The landlord is at liberty to reapply.

Conclusion

The landlord's application dated March 4, 2019 is withdrawn. The landlord is at liberty to reapply.
