Introduction

This hearing was scheduled to convene at 1:30 p.m. this date by way of conference call concerning an application made by the tenant seeking a monetary order for return of all or part of the pet damage deposit or security deposit and to recover the filing fee from the landlords for the cost of the application.

Both landlords attended the hearing prepared to respond to the tenant's application, however the line remained open while the telephone system was monitored for in excess of 10 minutes and no one for the tenant joined the call. Therefore, I dismiss the tenant's application without leave to reapply.

Conclusion

For the reasons set out above, the tenant's application is hereby dismissed without leave to reapply.
