Introduction

This hearing was convened in response to an Application for Dispute Resolution by the landlord for an Order of Possession, a monetary order for unpaid rent and to recover the filing fee.

The applicant landlord was provided with a copy of the Notice of a Dispute Resolution Hearing dated May 28, 2019 after filing their application on May 21, 2019. The landlord, however, did not attend the hearing set for today at 9:30 a.m. The phone line remained open for no less than ten minutes and was monitored throughout this time. The only parties to call into the hearing were the respondent tenant and their legal advocate.

Analysis and Conclusion

Following the ten minute waiting period prescribed by the Rules of Procedure, the application of the landlord was **dismissed, without leave to reapply**.
