Introduction

This hearing dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution by the tenant. The applicant tenant was provided with a copy of the Notice of a Dispute Resolution Hearing after filing their application dated May 29, 2019. The tenant, however, did not attend the hearing set for today at 11:00 a.m. The phone line remained open for ten minutes and was monitored throughout this time. The only party to call into the hearing was the respondent landlord. The landlord testified the parties had seemingly resolved the dispute.

Analysis and Conclusion

Following the ten minute waiting period, the application of the tenant was dismissed, without leave to reapply.
