<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was convened by way of conference call concerning an application made by the tenant seeking an order cancelling a notice to end the tenancy for unpaid rent or utilities.

The tenant and the landlord attended the hearing, during which the parties agreed to settle this dispute, and the 10 Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent or Utilities is cancelled and the tenancy continues. The parties confirmed at the end of the hearing that this agreement was made on a voluntary basis and that the parties understood the nature of this full and final settlement of this matter.

Conclusion

For the reasons set out above, and by consent, the 10 Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent or Utilities dated August 10, 2019 is hereby cancelled and the tenancy continues.
