Introduction

This hearing dealt with the tenant's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the *Act*) for cancellation of the One Month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause (the "One Month Notice"), pursuant to section 47.

Both parties attended the hearing and were each given a full opportunity to be heard, to present affirmed testimony, to make submissions, and to call witnesses.

The landlord testified that he cancelled the One Month Notice and that this tenancy is continuing. The tenant confirmed the landlord's above testimony and withdrew her application for dispute resolution. Pursuant to the above, I find that the One Month Notice dated October 30, 2019 is of no force or effect. As no further action is required with respect to the application, I dismiss the tenant's application with leave to reapply.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
