Introduction

This hearing dealt with the tenant's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "Act") for:

- cancellation of the landlord's 10 Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent (the "Ten-Day Notice") pursuant to section 46.

Both parties attended the hearing and were each given a full opportunity to be heard, to present affirmed testimony, to make submissions, and to call witnesses and cross-examine witnesses.

Since both parties attended the hearing and no party raised an issue of service, I find that the parties were both sufficiently served pursuant to section 71(2)(c) of the *Act*.

At the hearing, the landlord agreed to withdraw their Ten-Day Notice. Accordingly, I grant the tenant's application to cancel the 10 Day Notice pursuant to section 46. This tenancy shall continue until it ends pursuant to the *Act*.

Conclusion

The tenant's application to cancel the 10 Day Notice is granted. This tenancy shall continue until it ends pursuant to the *Act*.
