Introduction

On October 08, 2019, The Tenant applied for Dispute Resolution under the *Residential Tenancy Act* ("the Act") seeking a monetary order for money owed or compensation for damage or loss under the *Act*, and for the return of the security deposit and or pet damage deposit.
