# **DECISION**

<u>Dispute Codes</u> MNSD, MNDCT

#### Introduction

This hearing dealt with an application filed by the applicant pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act ("Act")*.

# The applicant sought:

- An order for the return of a security deposit or pet damage deposit pursuant to section 38 and
- A monetary order for damages or compensation pursuant to section 67;

Both the applicant and the respondent attended the hearing. Neither party raised any issues with timely service of documents.

#### Preliminary issue

In the respondent's evidence package, the respondent provided evidence to indicate she is the owner of the rental address and that she shared a kitchen and bathrooms with the tenant. This evidence consisted of floor plans of the rental address and a 2020 Notice of Assessment from the BC Assessment Authority. The applicant testified that the respondent misrepresented the rental address when advertising the accommodation, advising her that she would have a private bath and a separate cooking area. The applicant did not dispute that she and the owner of the rental address shared the living accommodation for the time she lived there.

## Section 4(c) of the *Act* states:

# What this Act does not apply to

- 4 This Act does not apply to:
- (c) living accommodation in which the tenant shares bathroom or kitchen facilities with the owner of that accommodation.

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Based on the evidence provided by the respondent and the applicant's testimony, I find the respondent/owner shared her living accommodation with the applicant. As such, I find that the *Residential Tenancy Act* does not apply to the living situation and I do not have the jurisdiction or authority to hear this matter pursuant to sections 4(3) and 62(1)(b) of the *Act*.

### Conclusion

I decline to hear this matter further as I have no jurisdiction to consider this application.
