<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with the tenant's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "*Act*") for:

- cancellation of the landlord's One Month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause (the One Month Notice) pursuant to section 47;
- an order requiring the landlord to comply with the Act, regulation or tenancy agreement pursuant to section 62;
- an order to the landlord to provide services or facilities required by law pursuant to section 65;
- authorization to recover the filing fee for this application pursuant to section 72.

All named parties attended the hearing. At the outset of the hearing, the parties confirmed that the tenant vacated the rental unit on March 19, 2020.

As the tenant voluntarily vacated prior to this hearing, the tenants' application to dispute the One Month Notice as well other matters identified in this application are moot. The tenant's application is dismissed in its entirety without leave to reapply.

This Decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the Residential Tenancy Act.
